* What's Accepted?

• **Mixed Recyclables**

- **Plastic:** All plastic bottles and jugs including water, milk, soda, juice, liquid soap, shampoo and detergent containers.
- **Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, envelopes, catalogs, bags, office paper, telephone books, shoe and cereal boxes, flattened cardboard.
- **Glass:** All glass food and beverage bottles and jars.
- **Cans and Metal:** All aluminum, tin, steel and bi-metal food and beverage containers, pots, pans, foil and trays.

• **Green Waste:** Tree branches and limbs (no larger than 3' long and 18" wide), grass, leaves, weeds, vegetables, and fruit. No poison oak.

• **Mixed Paper Only:** Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, envelopes, catalogs, bags, office paper, telephone books, shoe and cereal boxes, flattened cardboard.
