THE POSITION: This recruitment is being conducted to establish an eligibility list from which current and future full-time vacancies may be filled. The essential functions and corresponding duties of this position include:

- **Restraining and/or subduing individuals/physical performance**, including: Handcuffing suspects or prisoners; subduing attacking or resisting persons; using baton or other restraining devices; pursuing fleeing suspects on foot; pulling oneself up over obstacles; using bodily force to gain entrance.
- **Weapons handling**, including: Firing handgun/shotgun/rifle; Maintaining skill with weapon at range; Practicing safe weapons handling.
- **Emergency driving**, including: Engaging in high speed pursuit driving; Responding as backup unit to crime in progress; Transporting injured persons.
- **Oral communication**, including: Coordinating and taking charge of situations; Interviewing suspects, victims and witnesses; Giving accurate testimony in court.
- **Writing and diagramming**, including: Summarizing in writing, statements of witnesses/complainants; writing factual/complete reports; sketching accident and crime scenes.

THE POSITION WILL USE YOUR:

KNOWLEDGE OF: Basic law enforcement terminology and concepts. Techniques for dealing with people of all socio-economic levels under hostile and emergency situations. First aid methods and their applications. Safety practices and precautions pertaining to the work.

SKILL IN: Reading, interpreting and applying complex laws, procedures and policies; Observing and accurately recalling places, names descriptive characteristics and facts of incidents; remaining calm and taking appropriate action in tense situations; making rapid, sound judgments within legal and procedural guidelines; preparing clear and concise reports, records and other written materials; understanding and following oral and written directions; establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of the work

CANDIDATE MUST POSSESS THE FOLLOWING:

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: High School diploma or have proof of passing the general education development test (GED) with a minimum score of not less than 45. College coursework in criminology or police science is desirable.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS: Must be at least 21 years of age and U.S. citizen. Must be able to complete a California POST Law Enforcement Academy. Must be a California resident at time of appointment. Must possess a valid driver's license. Must be willing to work evening, night, weekend and holiday shifts. Must maintain a firearms qualification.

All applications will be reviewed and qualified applicants will be invited to participate in the examination process which may include: A written examination, physical ability test, oral interview and polygraph examination. Once certified to the Sheriff's Office list, all applicants will continue in the selection process which will include an updated background investigation and a psychological and medical examination.
