

DEPUTY SHERIFF II

APPROXIMATE MONTHLY SALARY: \$4191 - \$5094 (base pay)

THE POSITION: This recruitment is being conducted for the position of Deputy Sheriff II in the Sheriff's Office for Placerville and South Lake Tahoe. This recruitment will establish a one year eligibility list from which current and future full-time vacancies may be filled. The essential functions and corresponding duties of this position include:

- **Restraining and/or subduing individuals** by means of baton techniques, locks, grips or holds, or restraining devices such as handcuffs; Physical performance including lifting, carrying or dragging heavy objects, climbing or jumping over obstacles, running, balancing on narrow surfaces, or using bodily force; Weapons handling; Arrest and detain procedures;
- **First Aid techniques** including CPR; Surveillance requiring careful observation, use of binoculars and photographic equipment; Decision making; Review and recall of information; Inspecting/searching including buildings, people, and vehicles; securing and protecting property;
- **Emergency driving** including high speed driving; Oral/written communications including mediating confrontations with hostile or potentially hostile people, and using communications devices including radios and telephones;
- **Processing paperwork**, including forms and citations, and depicting crime/accident scenes in schematic form, using a wordprocessor, photocopiers and other office equipment; Reading statutes, legal transcripts, and other written reports and materials.

THE POSITION WILL USE YOUR:

KNOWLEDGE OF: Basic law enforcement terminology and concepts. Techniques for dealing with people of all socio-economic levels under hostile and emergency situations. First aid methods and their applications. Safety practices and precautions pertaining to the work.

SKILL IN: Reading, interpreting and applying complex laws, procedures and policies; Observing and accurately recalling places, names descriptive characteristics and facts of incidents; remaining calm and taking appropriate action in tense situations; making rapid, sound judgments within legal and procedural guidelines; preparing clear and concise reports, records and other written materials; understanding and following oral and written directions; establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of the work.

CANDIDATES MUST POSSESS THE FOLLOWING:

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: High School diploma or have proof of passing the general education development test (GED), must possess current POST certification from a California POST law enforcement academy or be currently enrolled in a California POST law enforcement academy and successfully complete the academy prior to hire date.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS: Must be at least 21 years of age and possess a valid driver's license. Must be a U.S. citizen and a California resident at time of appointment. Must be willing to work evening, night, weekend and holiday shifts. Must maintain a firearms qualification.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE: Official County application required.

Resumes may be attached but may not be substituted for any portion of the application. All applications will be reviewed and qualified applicants will be invited to participate further in the examination process which will include an oral examination. Those candidates who received passing scores during this process will be placed on the eligibility list in rank order based on their final scores. Successful candidates in subsequent testing cycles will be added to the existing list based on their scores. Therefore, an individuals rank on the eligibility list is subject to change. Once certified to the Sheriff's Department, candidates will continue in the selection process which will include a background investigation, drug screen test, psychiatric evaluation and medical examination.
