El Dorado County is in the process of updating its local Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. Please provide input on the following hazards:

Floods	Dam/Levee Failure	Storm Water
Winter Storms	Erosion	Sinkholes
Avalanche	Wildfire	Tornados
Seiche Wave	Earthquakes	Landslides
Drought/Extreme Heat	Severe Thunderstorms	

Prior Events: Angora Fire (June 2007), Winter Storm (January 2006), Spring Storm (March 2006), and January Storm 2008.

List prior damage/reimbursement from earlier events - *Example: During the 1997 heavy winter storms, DOT spent \$58,000 on debris removal and 10,000 placing signs and barricades to close roads and bridges, etc.*

Mitigation recommendations to reduce future damage from listed hazards - *Example: Gold Trail School District recommends replacing the 6 inch culvert at the entrance to their school parking lot with an 8 inch culvert to reduce the chance of flooding of their gymnasium.*
